Friday, 10 January 2025 *The WHY and WHAT of Reaching the Unreached TOGETHER*

Morning 8:00 AM to 10:30 AM, Room: OR Tambo

Speaker: Rev. Rev. Edgar Rueda, **Understanding God's Heart for the Unreached**

This session will challenge ICWC participants to embrace God's plan for the whole world, to know the Good News by aligning us with God's missionary heart, and to see the global scope of His Kingdom found in Scripture. This rally will also set the stage for the workshops that will focus on learning more about the background of many unreached people groups.

Rev. Edgar Rueda is the director of JIBACAM, the Wesleyan mission organization of The Ibero America Established Regional Conference. He is a pastor of the Wesleyan Church in the city of Medellín. He is a field missionary among Indigenous tribes in Columbia and writer of the book Despertar.

Speaker: Rev. Lester*, **Seeing Beyond the Barrier**

Lester has ministered with Global Partners among the Fotizo People since and still lives there with his wife, Amanda, and youngest son Josiah(17). He currently serves as the Turkic/Arabic Area Director for Global Partners, facilitating vision, strategic focus, and leadership coaching for each of the area church-planting and disciple-multiplication ministries. Before serving as a missionary, Lester was an assistant pastor for nine years where he disciplined and developed young leaders. Lester graduated with a Bachelor's degree from Oklahoma Wesleyan University (1999) and from Wesley Seminary with a Master's of Arts in Intercultural Studies (2022). He enjoys basketball, running, skiing, outdoors, and carpentry.
