Missionary Prayer Focus

 4. Send a care package. No matter how near or how far, a physical sign of blessings always uplifts a spirit.
 5. Faithfully commit to praying for them.

- **Praise** God for these willing individuals who have answered and are following the call to share the love of Christ around the world.
- **Pray** for our missionaries who will be far away from family and friends this Christmas season and to feel loved and cared for over the holidays.
- **Pray** for renewed joy and strength as they continue to build relationships and share the Gospel with unreached people groups (Psalm 90:14).
- **Pray** for health amongst the missionaries - spiritually, mentally, emotionally and physically. Pray for rest and a spirit of hope and encouragement.
